This project will be funded in part by the South Carolina Department of Commerce, Business Incentives and Community Development, under the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG). It will be administered by Catawba Regional Council of Governments. Federal requirements will apply to the contract. CDBG Contract Special Provisions will be included as part of any contract resulting from this solicitation. The selected engineer and other firms associated with the engineer are required to be registered in the federal System for Award Management prior to award of the contract and are to maintain an active registration for the duration of the project.

The selected engineer must comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. The Town of Great Falls encourages participation by Section 3 businesses.
