

The called meeting of the Great Falls Town Council was held on August 28, 2024, at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of Town Hall. Attending were Mayor Brantley, Council Members Craig, Dutton, Gonzalez and McManus; Council Member Worthy and Eagle were absent. Also attending was Town Clerk Eubanks, Reporter Jenkins and Chief Martin.

Mayor Brantley opened the meeting with Prayer.

Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Brantley declared emergency at the Police Department due to a collapsed terra cotta sewer pipe, allowing one quote for repairs. Council Member Dutton made a motion to approve the estimate by Parker Plumbing Solutions, LLC in the amount of \$12,500 to repair collapsed clay sewer pipe under the Police Department. Council Member Craig seconded the motion and asked where the money would come from. Council Non-budgeted. Chief Martin asked about the cost of repairs that will need to be made after the sewer line is fixed because the floors will be torn up and is worried about where the pipes go under walls. Mayor Brantley said they will revisit as needed for repairs. Council Member Gonzalez asked if there were more concerns with the building, like mold? Chief Martin stated the biggest issue is the sewer line. Mayor Brantley said they would check into getting moisture readings and cleaning up and replacing areas with mold. The motion was brought to a vote and passed unanimously.

There being no further business, Mayor Brantley made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Council Member Craig seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.
